4. FIRST AID MEASURES

EYE CONTACT:	Bathe/rinse the eye with running cold water for 15 minutes. Consult physician if necessary. May cause mild irritation. Repeated exposure may cause chronic eye irritation.
SKIN CONTACT:	Remove all contaminated clothes and footwear immediately unless stuck to skin. Wash the affected skin area with running water for 10 minutes or longer if substance is still on skin. If irritation develops or persists seek medical attention. May cause mild irritation to areas of broken or sensitive skin.
INGESTION:	If conscious, wash the mouth out with water. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. May cause mild irritation of the gastrointestinal tract if a large quantity is ingested. 5. FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES

EXPOSURE HAZARDS:	The product is not flammable but may support combustion. In combustion it emits toxic fumes of carbon dioxide/carbon monoxide and acrolein.
EXTINGUISHING MEDIA:	Suitable extinguishing media for the surrounding fire should be used. Compatible media: Carbon dioxide; polymer foam; Dry chemical powder. Water spray (do not use water jet) can be used to cool fire exposed surfaces or directly on the fire provided if the risk of spreading the fire is very low.
PROTECTION FOR FIRE-FIGHTERS:	Wear self-contained breathing apparatus. Wear protective clothing to prevent contact with skin and eyes.

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

PERSONAL PRECAUTIONS:	Avoid breathing vapours, mist or gas. Wear respiratory protection. Ensure adequate ventilation. Evacuate personnel to safe areas. Eliminate all sources of ignition. Wear suitable protective clothing. Do not handle the product without suitable protective clothing – see Section 8.
CLEAN-UP PROCEDURES:	Dilute the sample with a good amount of water before absorbing the spillage into a tissue or dry earth or inert absorbent material (depending on the quantity of spillage). After clean-up, wash the spillage site with a large amount of water. Dispose of waste as hazardous. Keep in suitable, closed containers for disposal.
ENVIRONMENTAL PRECAUTIONS:	Prevent further leakage or spillage if safe to do so. Do not let product enter drains. The product contains nicotine and can pose risk to aquatic animals if released in large quantities.

7. HANDLING AND STORAGE

HANDLING:	Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Avoid the formation or spread of mists in the air. Causes slippery surface when spilled. Ensure there is sufficient ventilation of the area.
STORAGE:	Store in cool, dry and well-ventilated area. Keep containers tightly closed. Protect from low temperatures, frost, direct sunlight or high temperatures. Ideal storage temperature range: between 20 to 25 degree Celsius.
SUITABLE PACKAGING:	Wherever possible, should only be kept in original packaging. Other suitable containers: Steel drums; Aluminium containers, glass containers, and high density polyethylene. Some rubbers and plastics (low density polyethylene) are attacked by the product.
